BE REAL, NOT FAKE: June 27th | Week 2

MAIN POINT AND BIBLE VERSE

Tell the truth. Be honest in all you say and do.

Proverbs 12:22 NLT

The LORD detests lying lips, but he delights in those who tell the truth.

1. What is one word you would use to describe yourself?
2. The verse says God hates lying. What do you think He doesn't like about it? Answers will vary.

REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. What do you think is so bad about lying? Answers will vary.
2. What do you think it means to be honest? Answers will vary. Idea: being truthful in all you say and do.
3. In the Bible story, two people died when they lied, but our bodies don't usually die when we lie. What do you think does die when we lie? Our reputation, the trust others have in us, etc.
4. Once you tell lies, what do you think can help people trust you again? Ask God to help you stay honest; pray God helps others see that God's changed you; tell the truth; keep your promises; etc.

ACTION STEP QUESTIONS

1. Share the name of someone you've lied to and you need to apologize to. Answers will vary.
2. Think of a lie you tell a lot. Tell your group what it is and ask them to pray God helps you quit telling that lie. Answers will vary.

PRAY TOGETHER

1. Ask kids to share things they'd like to pray about.
2. Write down their prayer requests.
3. Pray together over the prayer requests.

Not sure what to pray? Pray this: *God, thank You for helping us to be honest. Please help us turn to You when we find ourselves telling lies. In Jesus' name, amen.*
