



DAY THREE | **PRODIGAL SON** | ACTIVITY

Bible Verse: LUKE 15:11-32

The Point: THERE IS NO LIMIT FOR WHAT GOD CAN DO FOR YOU.

You Need: Penny
Dropper
Glass of Water

Directions:

Fill the dropper with water. Now make a guess at how many drops of water you can put on the top of the penny before the water spills over the edge. Now start dropping water, counting as you go.

Conclusion:

Just like God's love, there is no limit to how many drops of water you can add to the top of the penny. There is no limit to how far God will go to love you.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITY

You Need: straws, tape, small ball or marble, cardboard, pictures of parable characters

Directions:

Make a maze on a piece of cardboard using tape and straws. Tape the characters at opposite ends of the maze. Using the ball, move it around the maze by tilting the cardboard.

Conclusion:

There is no limit to how far God will go to love you.
