



**DAY TWO | LABORERS IN THE VINEYARD | ACTIVITY**

***\*Note to parents: today's activity can be played between several siblings, child and parent, or the child can compete for a better time the second round***

**KINDER - 2ND GRADE ACTIVITY**

Bible Verse: MATTHEW 20:1-16  
The Point: NO MATTER THE SITUATION, GOD'S GRACE IS FOR EVERYONE.  
You need: pipe cleaner  
Red and white beads  
Mini candy canes

We're going to play a game where the winner gets a prize! I'm going to set a timer, and you're going to put red and white beads on the pipe cleaner to look like a candy cane. *(Give the first player 20 seconds, the second player 30 seconds, and if there's a third player, 40 seconds).*

OK, let's count.  
Player 1 got \_\_\_\_ beads - you earned a candy cane!  
Player 2 got \_\_\_\_ beads - you earned a candy cane!  
Player 3 got \_\_\_\_ beads - you earned a candy cane!

Was this game fair? Why not? Did the winner get a better prize than the person in second or third place? We like for things to be fair, and competing to win is fun, but Jesus taught us that no matter what happens, we all get the same grace. Our mistakes might seem small, or they might seem really big, but no matter what, God's grace is big enough to cover it.

**3RD - 5TH GRADE ACTIVITY**

Bible Verse: MATTHEW 20:1-16  
The Point: NO MATTER THE SITUATION, GOD'S GRACE IS FOR EVERYONE.  
You need: Kix cereal  
Straw  
Plate or bowl  
Lollipops

We're going to play a game where the winner gets a prize! I'm going to set a timer, and you're going to use the straw to move the Kix from the bowl they're in to the plate/bowl next to it. *(Give the first player 20 seconds, the second player 30 seconds, and if there's a third player, 40 seconds).*

OK, let's count.  
Player 1 got \_\_\_\_ pieces - you earned a lollipop!  
Player 2 got \_\_\_\_ pieces - you earned a lollipop!  
Player 3 got \_\_\_\_ pieces - you earned a lollipop!

Was this game fair? Why not? Did the winner get a better prize than the person in second or third place? How does that make you feel? We like for things to be fair, but do we REALLY want life to be fair? The Bible tells us that everyone sins, and that the price for sin is death. But Jesus died to cover our sins so that we can live a life free from sin and close to God. Our mistakes might seem small, or they might seem too big to ask for forgiveness, but no matter what, God has enough grace to cover it.
