Matthew 5:43-44 NLT

"You have heard the law that says, 'Love your neighbor' and hate your enemy. But I say, love your enemies! Pray for those who persecute you!"

ICEBREAKER QUESTION

What are the hardest foods to eat with a fork?

LESSON QUESTIONS

1. What was your favorite part of the message today? What's one thing you learned?
2. What's your answer to today's big question? (*Printed above*)
3. Read Matthew 5:43-44 NLT. These are the words of Jesus. What is He saying about bullies? Why do you think He wants us to pray for them?
4. When is it hard for you to forgive others?
5. Think back to today's game where we tried to draw something we thought would be fun to draw—with the opposite hand we usually draw with. Was it natural or easy to do? If you stopped drawing with your preferred hand and started using only your other hand, what do you think it would be like a year from now?
6. What did today's drawing activity have to do with loving and praying for our enemies? Do you think you can get better at loving even people who are unkind with practice?
7. If someone is hurting you in some way, how can you stand up for yourself and tell them to stop while still loving them? Who can you ask for help if the person who is bullying you won't stop?
