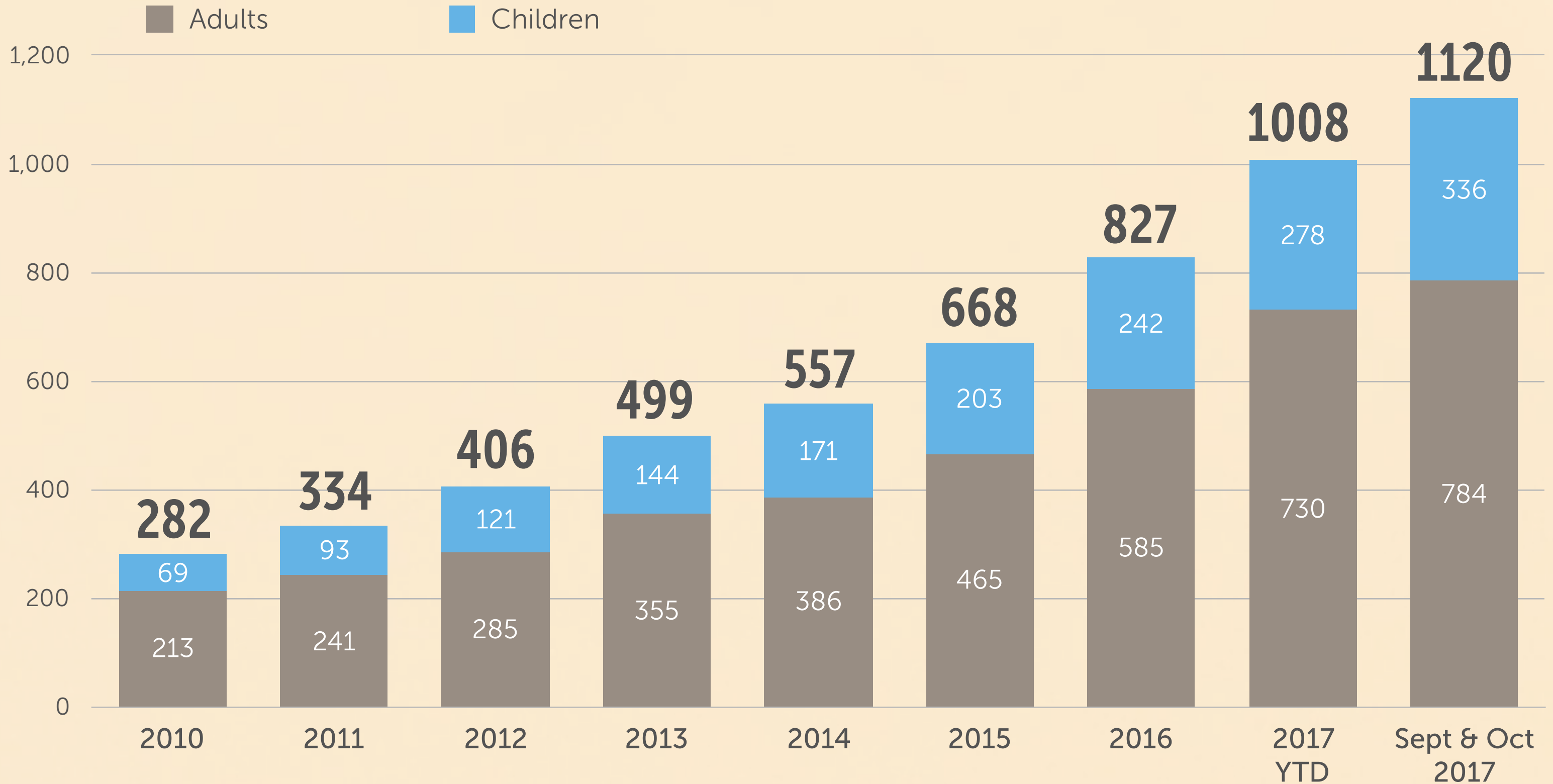
# ATTENDANCE AVERAGE BY YEAR

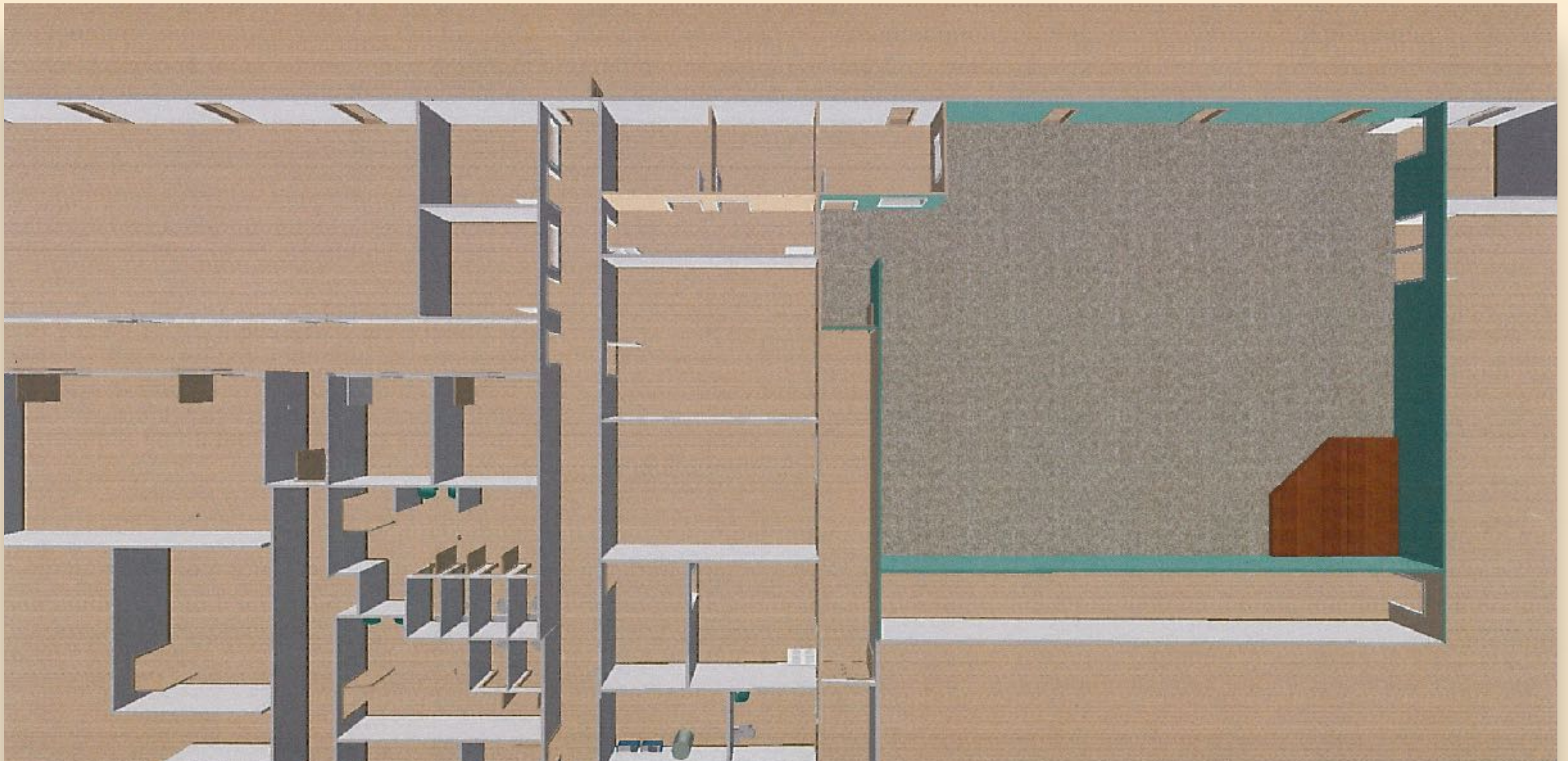

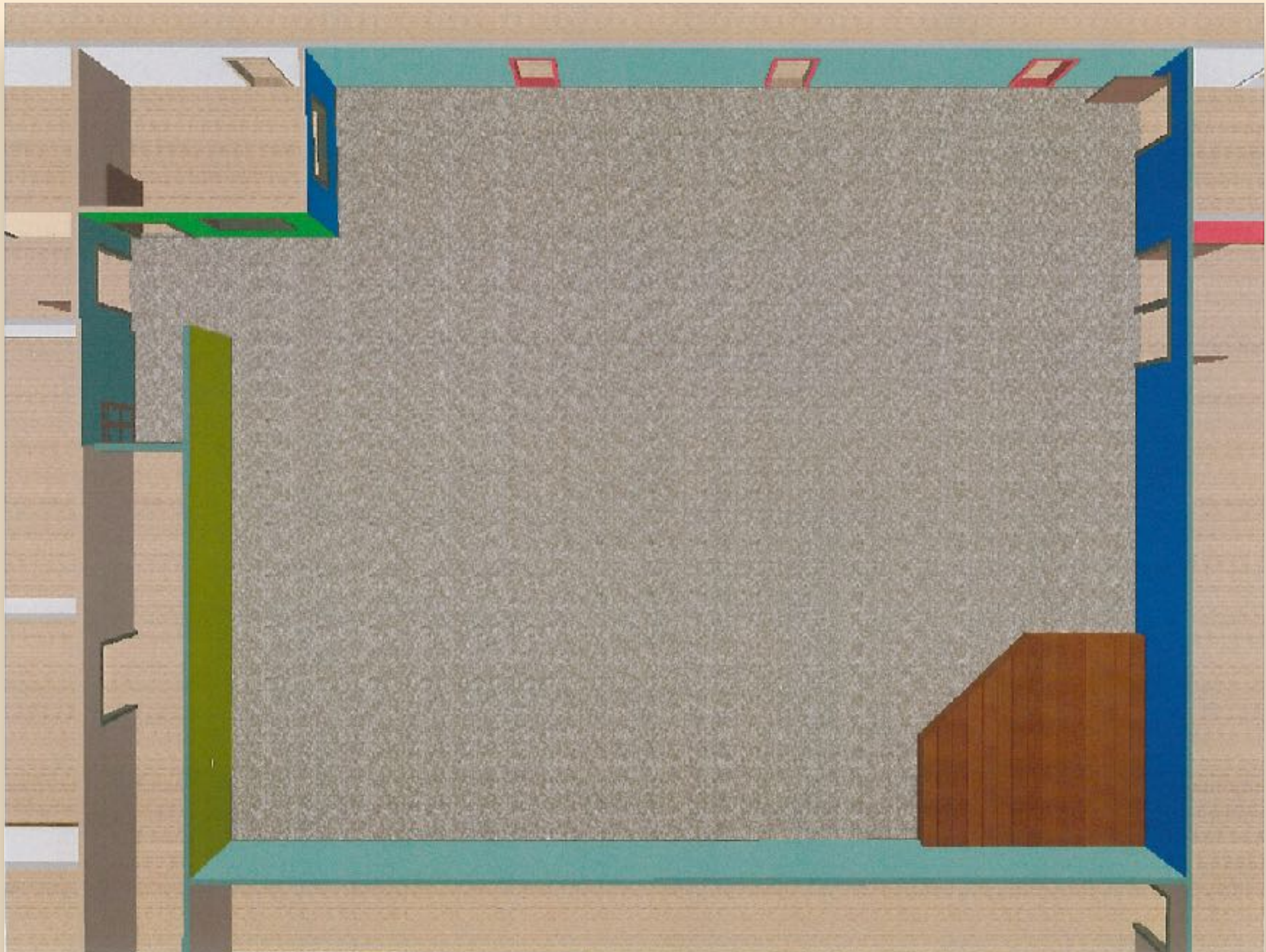
# ATTENDANCE AVERAGE BY YEAR
