Big Question

The Verse

Ephesians 4:14-15 NLT, "Then we will no longer be immature like children. We won't be tossed and blown about by every wind of new teaching. We will not be influenced when people try to trick us with lies so clever they sound like the truth. Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church."

6. Think about someone in your life that you often disagree with (but, to be as respectful as possible, keep their name to yourself). What is one specific way you can show love to them this week? Where could you find common ground with them?
